



FEBRUARY 11, 2017 – KATHGARH

In association with Max India Foundation, MSFL promotes the cause of **Healthcare, Education, Environment and Nutrition** among communities in its neighborhood. At the local village, MSFL has opened a health dispensary and held health, blood donation and limb donation camps.

The most recent camp was organized on 11th February 2017 in Village Kathgarh. Senior specialists – Dr. Harpreet Kapoor (Eye), Dr. Ashok Gupta (Internal Medicine) and Dr. Pushkin Sharma (Orthopedics) – from Max Super Specialty Hospital were in attendance. They examined patients, young and old. 55 senior citizens were diagnosed with cataract and 34 were prescribed spectacles. ECGs were carried out on 28 patients and 53 had their bone density checked.

Mr. SP Bansal led the team of CSR volunteers from MSFL. The team provided logistical support, while Dr. SMS Sidhu and his crew extended administrative support.

A ceremonious welcome by the panchayat awaited the teams from MSFL and Max Healthcare. Mr. SP Bansal was presented with a siropa.

So far MSFL has conducted as many as 26 medical camps. Their efforts have helped 7415 patients overcome health issues. The next camp will be held in the third week of March.
